Caregiver Profile vs. Filter List

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Research Goals

- Determine what items are **most** important to have in a “Filter By” option on the “Caregiver List”
- Determine what items are important to have in a “Caregiver Profile”

Methods

- Card sort, n=19
- Participants sorted 49 cards provided by project collaborators into three groups, “Filter By”, “Caregiver Profile”, and “Other”
- Participants were a convenience sample from a class of graduate students at Claremont Graduate University
- Study was unmoderated and conducted remotely using Mural
- Participants were encouraged to create their own categories if they wished. Participant created groups were recorded as “Other”.

Results

Selection Criteria

Standard Criteria

- **>50%** of respondents chose the category
- The percent difference in selections of “Filter By” and “Caregiver Profile” is **>25%**

Both Criteria

- The percent difference in selections of “Filter By” and “Caregiver Profile” is **<25%**

Uncategorized Criteria

- Items did not get **>50%** in either “Filter By” or “Caregiver Profile”

Uncategorized

Results for these items is inconclusive, further research is recommended

- Housekeeping
- Long Distance Transport
- Memory Care
- Seizure Assistance
- Special Needs
- Specialized Care
- Specific Diagnosis
- Transportation

Limitations

- Participants were not screened

Unknowns:

- Relevance of service to participants
- Attitudes towards healthcare providers
- Knowledge of healthcare industry

Future Research

- Additional research to clarify inconclusive items
- Some participants broke up “Caregiver Profile” into subcategories, consider further investigation/benefits of implementing subcategories
